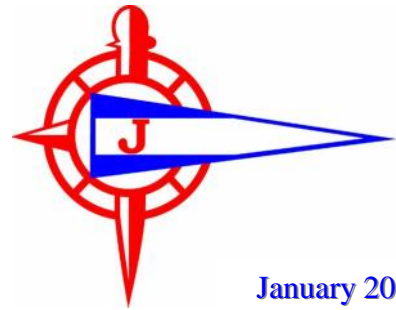

Subject: Sail Boat Cove Changes

Changes to signs and hours of access for Sail Boat Cove go into effect January 1, 2012. These changes are designed to improve security and safety for annual permit holders and their boats. These changes will clearly define and post the hours of access for annual permit holders and the general public.

## Main Gate - Sail Boat Cove

The main gate to Sail Boat Cove is equipped with a combination padlock and signs to notify all, that the gate closes at sunset. Please ensure that the gate is properly re-locked after opening. A locked gate will notify others that the area is closed. Also, leaving a gate open and/or unlocked can result in damage to vehicles. If you give out the combination, please instruct the recipient of the requirements and proper procedures.

## Access by Permit Holders Only from 10PM to 8AM

It is Jackson County Parks & Recreation Department's position that Sail Boat Cove is a public use area; and as such, must be generally accessible to the public. An exception to this is being made so a permit holder may use the area to sleep overnight on their boat. While this activity seems similar to camping, the area does not lend itself to traditional security measures. The Parks Department recognizes the need for placement of specific signs in an effort to deter non-permit holders from accessing the area during established times. Fishermen or other members of the general public are not allowed in the area during these hours.

Additional signs read: "Area Closed From 10:00 PM – 8:00 AM. Access for permit holders only."

## Shelter House Reservation

In appreciation of the efforts by the Jacomo Cruiser Fleet Yacht Club and other permit holders to beautify and maintain Sail Boat Cove, posted signs now designate the shelter as a public use shelter, but not available on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month, March through October, from 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM.

## Conflict Resolution

These signs are intended to improve security and eliminate conflicts. Enforcement actions will be based on County Ord. 5010.1 Park Closing, in response to a call for service (816-503-4890). A responding Ranger will conduct a preliminary investigation; and then, based upon findings and at her/his discretion, implement one of these courses of action:

The ranger would request that the person(s) leave the area immediately with no further action required.

The ranger would issue a written warning to document the contact, request that the person(s) leave the area immediately; and, create a record. Future contacts would include a record search and if present, escalated enforcement action.

The ranger would issue a GOS and request that the person(s) leave the area immediately.
